ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

Delivered in partnership with Uisce Éireann, Water Stewardship Ireland and the Sustainable Enterprise Skillnet, this programme supports business customers in addressing water quality and related risks, meeting mandatory reporting needs, and developing strategies to prepare for trade effluent charges.



Who is the Programme for?

This programme is aimed at those responsible for water management within their company, offering practical tools to respond to regulatory requirements and rising costs.

Programme Delivery and Duration

This is a blended training course and will take approximately 8 weeks to complete. Places will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis, subject to Uisce Éireann approval.

Programme Deliverables

- Training on water quality
- Strategies for trade effluent compliance
- Drainage and water balance mapping
- Site-level actions to reduce, reuse & restore water
- Learn from the experience of your peers in other facilities
