Develop a Water Charter for your site

All participants will prepare a Water Charter for their facility. The charter will capture the business case for action, the site's water map, water saving opportunities and an agreed action plan.

Identify business drivers for water stewardship and get training on water conservation and quick wins at your site to drive behavioural change.



Practical Technical Sills

Gain the technical skills you need in water mapping, conservation and planning. Map and visualise water use at the facility to engage all stakeholders.



Planning, Targeting and Tracking

Complete a water stewardship strategy and charter for senior management. Develop water specific targets and start to track progress.

Discover best international practices in corporate water stewardship and learn from the experiences of your peers in other facilities.
